## MEMORIZATION PROJECT | Fall 2017

When it comes to living God's Truth, we believe it's best to know it by heart. That's why we're excited to continue helping kids memorize Scripture and biblical truths that fit with the lessons from our curriculum: *Lost & Found*.

**HOW IT WORKS** To encourage the kids to get involved, we're rewarding memorization success and other commendable Christ-like actions with award stickers each week.

Students can earn stickers the following ways:

- Memorizing one verse every week
- Memorizing the Big Idea Truth from the previous lesson
- Memorizing the Beatitudes
- Attending and showing self-control each week
- Bringing a friend

**THE GOAL** Over the 13-week semester, we've challenged the students to work toward the following goals:

- **PreK–1<sup>st</sup> Grade:** Earn 20 stickers
- **2<sup>nd</sup>–4<sup>th</sup> Grade:** Earn 30 stickers

**THE REWARDS** In December, we'll honor diligent students who've reached their goal with an award celebration and treats.

### 1 MEMORIZING | Scripture

### 2 MEMORIZING | Big Idea Truth
